Parent Question: Are there any restrictions on the number of family members permitted to attend Back-to-School Night?

Principal's Answer: Back-to-school night is meant primarily for parents with the understanding that sometimes parents need to bring their children along. There are no restrictions on who or how many family members may attend, but please try to minimize the number of children in attendance.
