- **SOL results**
 - o SOL scores are still coming in as retakes are still ongoing
 - o Current Overall:
 - Reading score is 94%, same as last year.
 - Math score is 94.1%. Last year it was 91%. Glenkirk's Math SOL score might be one of the highest in the county. Scores are still coming in.

- Science & Social Studies score is 73.9%.
- ESOL pass score is 63%, which could be the top 5 schools with the highest score.
- SPED pass score is 73.9%. This is a pretty high pass score and with data still coming in we might be around top 3 schools with the highest pass score.

 - Class picnics will start on Thursday, June 5th
 - Field Day will take place on Friday, June 6th
